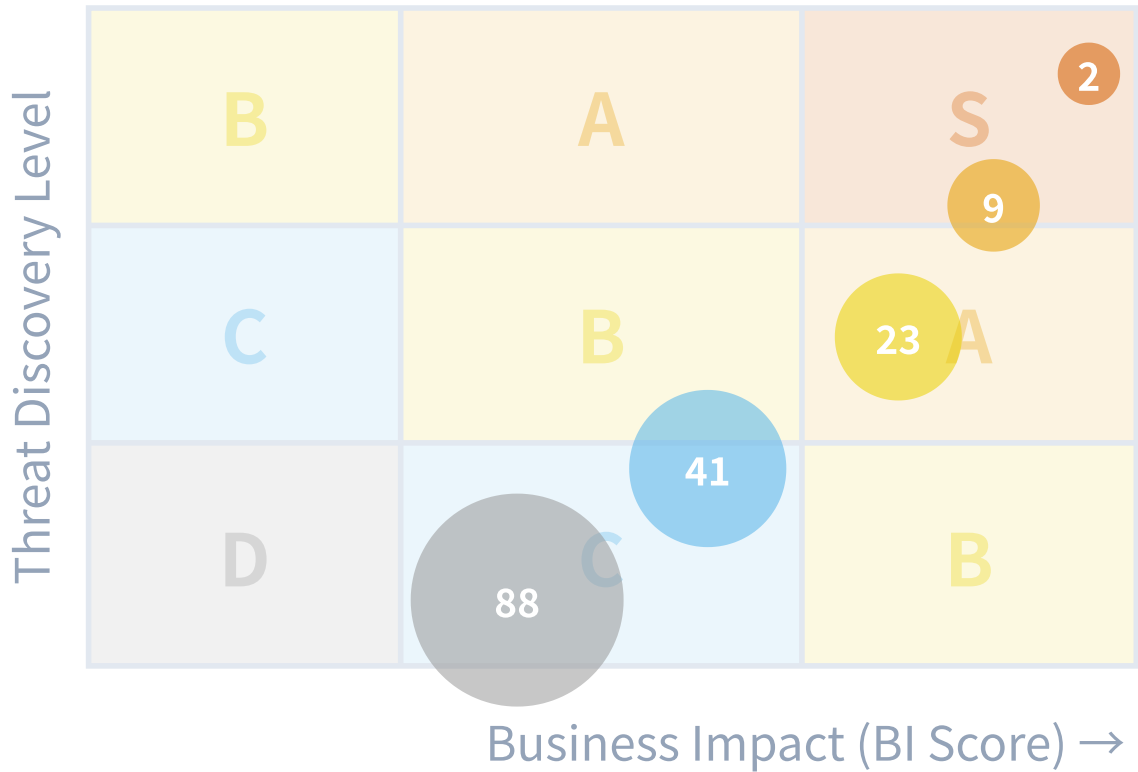

There are two band S findings and nine in band A. Band S is down from three last week, but both remaining findings sit on externally reachable hosts, and one of them is on a component with confirmed exploitation in the wild. Treat that one first. Deep scan validation has covered 37 findings; 12 remain unvalidated.

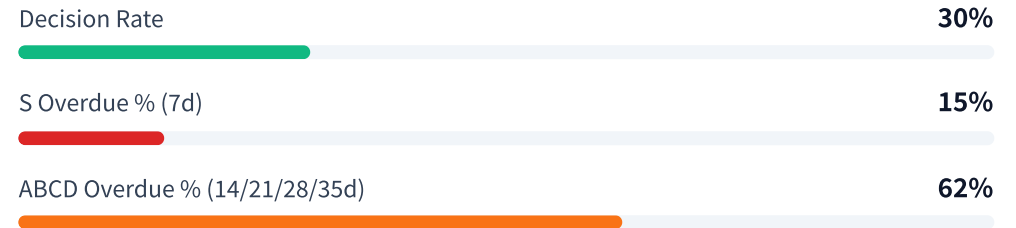


CISO Insight (Weekly AI)

The grouping rate reached 92% and asset classification 85%, so the inventory work is largely in place. What remains is owner assignment, which sits at 78%. Assets without an owner are slow to move once a finding appears. We suggest listing the unassigned assets this week.

CISO Insight (Weekly AI)

The decision rate is 30% and the resolution rate 12.5%, both low. Nine findings are more than seven days past due, three more than 14 days, and two more than 30 days; one of those is band S. The band S overdue rate is 15% against 62% for bands A to D, so lower-priority findings are the ones piling up. Clear the single band S item first, then assign owners to the two items past 30 days.
